

AP Class Supply List

AP Biology

1. 3-inch three-ringed binder
2. Binder dividers **(10)**
3. Loose leaf paper
4. EACH UNIT PACKET (I will supply ONE copy at the beginning of each unit)
5. Calculator
6. Pencil – ALL work must be done in pencil ONLY
7. Red pen - for grading in class

AP Calculus

1. Textbook (handed out in first class)
2. TI-84 calculator (this is the calculator I will use for demonstrative purposes)
3. Pencils/erasers
4. Red pen (or different ink color- not purple) for corrections and grading
5. Notebook (for class notes- 3-subject recommended) (can use a graph ruled notebook if preferred)
6. Loose leaf paper (for turn-in assignments)
7. Binder or folder (to organize materials; need space for worksheets, assignments, quizzes/tests)

AP Lang

1. Organized Three-Ring Binder: I require that students in this class maintain a three-ring binder, with multiple tabs and spare notebook paper. They should include AT LEAST the following sections:

- a. Handouts. There will be many handouts in AP Lang that students will read and analyze for a grade, so they must remain organized.
- b. AP practice essays. Students should keep any essays handed back in preparation for the AP test.
- c. Returned work.
- d. Notes. It is vital to take notes and keep them throughout the year in preparation for the AP test.
- e. Spare lined paper

2. A spiral notebook. I require that students take notes in a spiral notebook dedicated solely to AP Lang.

3. Sticky notes- Students will need at least one pad of sticky notes for annotating the school copies of Hamlet. Students may need more sticky notes, depending on whether they choose to annotate in their personal books or not.

4. Pens and pencils

5. Computer with internet access

6. Students are responsible for ordering the following books themselves:

- a. The Abolition of Man by C.S. Lewis
- b. My Grandfather's Son by Clarence Thomas
- c. The Gospel in Dostoevsky: Selections from His Works (introduced by J.I. Packer, with Malcom Muggeridge and Ernest Gordon)
